**Tick Warning Signs:**

We are willing to help install them but are not interested in maintaining them.

**Foot Paths Revisited:**

John Bakewell reported that 2 miles of foot paths have been constructed. He has been asked to investigate possible new “links and extensions.” He asked the Trails Committee to come up with a priority list of the links that would be most useful to connecting trails in town. He mentioned the following list:

Westford St - to the town line.

Kimballs - Stearns St.

Bedford Rd. - East St - library

Westford St. - Rockland Rd – Monroe Hill

School St. – Bellow Hill Rd.

Bedford Rd – Brook St.

Concord Rd – town line

East St. – Rutland Rd.

Louise, with Kevin Smith’s help, offered to come up with a map showing proposed links, dividing each into identifiable segments, all by the next meeting.
