Old Business:

Approve Meeting Minutes:

Boy Scout Trail Project at Spencer Brook:

It would be 10 to 16 feet in length and a maximum of about 2 feet above the water. He also proposed placing a "Bert's Bench" nearby overlooking the Spencer Brook Marsh.

Rodgers Road Trail:

A request to remove downed trees on the Rodgers Road easement has been received from Mary Zoll.

Trail Signs:
