**Approve Meeting Minutes:**

The minutes for the November 7, 2014 meeting were approved as amended (spelling).

**Spalding to Banta Boardwalk:**

Alan reported that some of the helical piers have been installed, at least partially.  
The trail will be cleared this Saturday morning.

**Davis Corridor Boardwalk:**

Thirty volunteers showed up on the 8<sup>th</sup> and performed a first, completing the 63-foot boardwalk in one day. On the 15<sup>th</sup>, 25 volunteers reported for work, and a short boardwalk was built, and some trail clearing was accomplished before noon.

It was voted unanimously to reimburse Steve Tobin for boardwalk hardware of \$44.76, to be taken from the CPC fund.

It was voted unanimously to reimburse Steve Tobin for lumber from Concord Lumber for \$1259.41, to be taken from the CPC fund.
